Eight thousand Android tablets, managed and locked down for the classroom and shipped into a conflict zone, with under a month to make it work.

THE CHALLENGE

Eight thousand tablets, one month, a moving target

Library For All had 8,000 Android tablets ready to ship to Ukraine within the month, and no way to manage them. Once the kits left headquarters there would be no visibility and no control: no guarantee the devices were secure, child-safe and up to date, no way to keep the right apps and content in place, and no way to stop devices being repurposed. Checking thousands of tablets by hand was never an option.

THE APPROACH

Locked down, localised, ready to teach

The tablets were set up with zero-touch: the full suite of learning apps pushed silently to every device before deployment, a kiosk launcher restricting each tablet to only what the classroom needed, and provisioning straight into Ukrainian language and locale the moment a device was taken out of the box. Content and security updates could then be delivered remotely, over local connectivity, from anywhere in the world.

THE OUTCOME

In the field, under the wire

The estate was enrolled and deployed inside the deadline, cutting time to deployment and the need for people on the ground. Library For All kept full remote control of thousands of tablets from anywhere, keeping learning going for children in the harsh, remote and off-grid conditions the charity builds for.
